SUBJECT: Delegation of Authority – Availability of Funds

1. In accordance with DFAS-In Regulation 37-1, Army Accounting and Fund Control, Chapter 3, 0317, you, Colonel Richard L. Agee, are delegated the authority to certify as to the availability of funds for the Headquarters, U.S. Army Medical Department Center & School and Fort Sam Houston, Fort Sam Houston, TX. You are also delegated the authority to establish and maintain administrative control of funds in accordance with DFAS-IN Regulation 37-1.
2. A complete set of all delegation memorandums should also be retained at your office.
